Clues for Logic Puzzle: E484YF

1. Whitney's piece costs 50 dollars less than the piece made of chestnut.
2. The rocking chair was made of poplar.
3. Nadine's piece is the end table.
4. Antoinette's item costs 25 dollars more than the item made of elm.
5. Hope's piece doesn't cost \$275.
6. Neither Kendra's piece nor the \$350 item is the barstool.
7. The \$275 piece wasn't made of rosewood.
8. The footstool costs 25 dollars less than Nadine's piece.
9. Josephine's piece costs 25 dollars more than the bench.
10. Whitney's item is either the \$250 piece or the \$350 item.
11. Neither Kendra's piece nor Josephine's item is the piece made of walnut.
12. The piece made of teak costs 125 dollars more than the piece made of rosewood.
13. The hutch was made of mahogany.
14. The item made of chestnut is either the \$325 item or Shelley's item.
15. Of the \$375 item and the item made of chestnut, one is the footstool and the other was crafted by Kendra.
16. Antoinette's piece was made of poplar.
