3. Neither the shipment that cost \$4.75 nor the package going to Bingham is the package with the fruit basket in it.
4. The shipment with the tea set in it isn't going to Bingham.
5. The shipment with the fruit basket in it isn't Zachary's.
6. The package with the rare book in it cost 1 dollar less than the shipment going to Hinton.
7. The shipment with the fruit basket in it isn't Christopher's.
8. The shipment going to Hinton is Christopher's.
9. The shipment that cost \$9.75 isn't Neil's.
10. The package going to Waterville isn't Zachary's.
11. The package going to Bingham cost 1 dollar less than the package with the computer in it.
12. The shipment that cost \$6.75 is Brad's.
13. Neither Christopher's package nor the shipment that cost \$7.75 is the shipment with the rare book in it.
14. Of Alexander's shipment and the package going to Quimby, one cost \$10.75 and the other contains the basketball.
