3. Felicia was awarded some amount less than the person who will major in Chemistry.
4. The person who's going to Penn State won't major in Theology.
5. Of Felicia and Wilma, one will major in Astronomy and the other received the \$35,000 scholarship.
6. Anna was awarded \$10,000 less than the student who will major in German Poetry.
7. The student who's going to Yale will major in Philosophy.
8. Iris was awarded \$15,000 more than the person who will major in Archaeology.
9. The person who will major in Astronomy was awarded \$10,000 less than the person who's going to Stanford.
10. Neither the person who's going to Harvard nor the person who's going to Stanford is the student who will major in Theology.
