## Clues for Logic Puzzle: Z426JN

1. The order with ham costs 1 dollar more than the order with salami.
2. Zachary's order includes swiss cheese.
3. The order with colby jack cheese costs 1 dollar more than the order with salami.
4. The sandwich with prosciutto costs 4 dollars more than the sandwich with roast beef.
5. Greg's order costs 2 dollars more than Zachary's sandwich.
6. The order with gouda cheese is either the $\$ 7.75$ sandwich or Emily's order.
7. Neither the sandwich with liverwurst nor Zachary's sandwich is the $\$ 3.75$ sandwich.
8. The order with colby jack cheese costs less than Ronda's sandwich.
9. The sandwich with liverwurst is either the order with havarti cheese or the order with swiss cheese.
10. Of the $\$ 4.75$ sandwich and the sandwich with provolone cheese, one is Zachary's and the other includes corned beef.
11. Darrell's order costs more than the sandwich with muenster cheese.
12. Of the sandwich with corned beef and the $\$ 5.75$ sandwich, one includes havarti cheese and the other is Kenneth's.
13. The seven sandwiches are the order with bologna, Kenneth's order, the sandwich with colby jack cheese, the $\$ 2.75$ sandwich, the order with havarti cheese, the order with gouda cheese and Zachary's sandwich.
