11. The one that sold for \$65 came out sometime after the one bought by Melvin.
12. Blaster Boy was purchased by Kyle.
13. Magic Marbles is either the one that sold for \$95 or the one bought by Eduardo.
14. Victorforce came out 2 years after the game that sold for \$55.
15. The game bought by Tommy came out 1 year after Gator Attack.
16. Neither AWOL Alert nor Troop Seven is the video game that sold for \$80.
17. Victorforce sold for \$65.
18. The video game that sold for \$60 is either the game bought by Kyle or the game bought by Phillip.
