## Clues for Logic Puzzle: D550ID

1. Of the tea that costs \$7.50 and the tea that requires 185 degree water, one is the Red Robe and the other steeps for 4 minutes.
2. The tea that costs \$10.50 doesn't steep for exactly 3.5 minutes.
3. The variety that requires 215 degree water costs 1 dollar less than the Iron Monk.
4. The variety that costs \$7.50 is either the variety that requires 200 degree water or the Pouchong.
5. The tea that steeps for 2.5 minutes costs 3 dollars more than the Iron Monk.
6. The Dong Ding doesn't cost \$10.50.
7. The variety that requires 205 degree water is either the variety that costs \$8.50 or the Pouchong.
8. The Dong Ding, the tea that costs \$6.50, the variety that steeps for 3 minutes, the tea that costs \$7.50 and the variety that requires 215 degree water are all different teas.
9. The Dan Cong doesn't cost \$10.50.
10. The tea that requires 195 degree water is either the tea that steeps for 2 minutes or the tea that costs \$10.50.
11. Neither the tea that requires 195 degree water nor the variety that costs \$9.50 is the variety that steeps for 3 minutes.
12. Of the Iron Monk and the Ali Shan, one needs 205 degree water and the other steeps for 4 minutes.
13. The variety that costs \$5.50 doesn't steep for exactly 2 minutes.
