- The 5 people were the collector who has 32 baseball cards, Kristian, the person with the Macedonian penpal, the person whose table is made of brazilwood, and the collector who has 69 baseball cards.
- Of the person with the Thai penpal and Cheyenne, one has 22 baseball cards and the other has the table made of yew.
- The person whose table is made of yew has more baseball cards than the person whose table is made of redwood.
- The person whose table is made of brazilwood has more baseball cards than the person with the Syrian penpal.
- The collector who has 32 baseball cards is Cheyenne.
- Either the person with the Thai penpal or the person with the Malian penpal is Trinity.
- The person whose table is made of hickory is not Kristian or Cristopher.
- The person with the Syrian penpal has fewer baseball cards than the person with the Thai penpal.
- The person with the Thai penpal is not Cristopher.
- The person whose table is made of balsawood has the Malian penpal.
