2. The tourist who bought the novelty license plate is not Baylee.
3. The person with a reservation at 7:00pm bought the novelty t-shirt.
4. The baker who made gingerbread cookies has a later reservation than the baker who made almond cookies.
5. The tourist who bought the novelty license plate has a later reservation than Madalyn.
6. Of the tourist who bought the novelty t-shirt and Madison, one has the 7:00pm reservation and the other baked black and white cookies.
7. Madalyn didn't buy a novelty figurine and didn't bake chocolate chip cookies.
8. The person with a reservation at 6:30pm baked black and white cookies.
9. The person with a reservation at 7:30pm didn't bake gingerbread cookies.
10. The person with a reservation at $8: 30 \mathrm{pm}$ is Baylee.
