4. AWOL Alert wasn't bought by Ivan.
5. The video game that sold for $\$ 60$ came out 3 years after the game bought by Ivan.
6. The video game bought by Alfred came out 1 year after the video game that sold for $\$ 65$.
7. Troop Seven was purchased by Clinton.
8. The video game that sold for $\$ 75$ is either the one bought by Kyle or the one that came out in 1986.
9. The video game that came out in 1986 wasn't bought by William.
10. Victorforce was purchased by William.
11. Of the one that came out in 1984 and the game that sold for $\$ 45$, one is Magic Marbles and the other was purchased by Alfred.
12. The video game that came out in 1986 sold for $\$ 50$.
13. Gator Attack is either the game that sold for $\$ 90$ or the video game that came out in 1988.
14. The game bought by Alfred is either the one that sold for $\$ 90$ or Countershot.
