- The patient who was prescribed quinapril has a later wake-up call than Mya.

- Of the patient who was prescribed ramipril and Nicholas, one has the KNZ-771 license plate and the other has the JJE-481 license plate.

- Either the one with the 7:30am wake-up call or the one with the 8:00am wake-up call has the SUV-332 license plate.
