2. The order with provolone cheese costs 1 dollar less than the order with ham.
3. Archie's order doesn't include bologna.
4. The order with muenster cheese costs 1 dollar more than Archie's sandwich.
5. The sandwich with liverwurst costs 2 dollars more than the order with roast beef.
6. Sue's sandwich is either the order with liverwurst or the order with ham.
7. Kenneth's order costs more than the order with gouda cheese.
8. The sandwich with havarti cheese costs 1 dollar more than Mildred's order.
9. The order with salami costs 1 dollar more than the order with roast beef.
10. Of the sandwich with liverwurst and the order with cheddar cheese, one is Omar's and the other costs \$2.75.
11. Sue's order costs $\$ 7.75$.
12. The $\$ 5.75$ order is either Archie's order or the order with prosciutto.
13. Lula's sandwich, the order with salami, the sandwich with colby jack cheese, the order with ham and the $\$ 8.75$ order are all different sandwiches.
14. The order with colby jack cheese costs 1 dollar more than the order with havarti cheese.
